#### 1.0 Preliminaries

1.0 Opening remarks from President

Some EB members experienced difficulties in connecting to the EB meeting through InEvent. The response to the GC survey indicated that the vast majority of individuals did not have problems connecting to the GC via InEvent. **PB and Mirko will draft written instructions to help members troubleshoot connection problems, and a practice meeting will be held to verify that all members can connect.** 

## NAFCC Representative

KA welcomed Dr. Ted Dunn, from Toronto, Canada, who is the tentative replacement for Dr. Stephen Hill as the NAFCC Representative.

## IFCC General Conference

The General Conference was very successful, as evidenced by response to the survey, and KA extended thanks to all for their efforts. A report will be generated for the next EB meeting (KA, DK, AHA, PB).

## Website Redevelopment

The new website is almost compete and is working very well, with only a few last minute updates to complete. The website should be lauched in early 2023.

Dubai 2024 WorldLab COC and Scientific Congress Committee Membership
A COC meeting for the Dubai 2024 meeting was held in Dubai in early December,
including MZ Events and the UAE colleagues. The committee inspected the conference
center, which is very attractive and functional, and have reserved additional conference
space in case the attendance is larger than can be accommodated in the space booked in
the congress centre. The Scientific Committee should start meeting in January, 2023. In
addition to international exhibitors and sponsors, a number of local exhibitors are expected
to attend the congress.

## Rome 2023 EuroMedLab

A COC meeting for the Rome EML Congress was held in November. There will be three satellite meetings, plus the YS Forum which will be open to all YSs, at no separate registration cost (registration will be required for the full congress). Twenty-five scholarships will be provide though IFCC, plus 10 from Roche, and 5-10 from EFLM. A new scholarship review/selection committee has been established and will coordinate with the Regional Federations to ensure that Young Scientists do not receive more that one scholarship. The Congress will be accredited thought EFLM, working with Sedef and MZ.

## Updates/Changes to IFCC Professional Exchange Program

The call for applications in October is now closed and 30 applications have been received. A meeting will be arragned soon to select the successful applicants. There will be another call for applications in March 2023. The call for labs to host PEPs is an open call and labs can be added at any time.

#### IFCC Virtual Platform

The InEvent training is now completed. Additional training and instructions will be provided as needed.

## IFCC-JCTLM-ICHCLR

There have been discussisons and email exchanges in support of the proposed role and structure of JCTLM, including agreement from Svere.

## Updates to IFCC Conference Guidelines

KA is drafting some additional changes to the IFCC Conference Guidelines. KA will email revised IFCC Conference Guidelines to the EB in December or January, for review and approval.

## New IFCC Taskforce on Environmental Impact of Lab Medicine

The Terms of Reference will be competed and a call for nominatins released in January. **PB, KA and DK will work on this.** 

#### Proposal for a 2nd IFCC virtual meeting on COVID-19

KA talked to Giuseppi and it is agreed that the congress should be held in September because March is too close to EML, and it will focus on pandemics in general (not just COVID-19) and the laboratory role.

#### Global MEDLAB Week 2023

The Committee on Public Relations is working with a marketing company on the campaign for 2023.

## MOU with FIFBCML- Francophone Federation

A draft MoU with FIFIBCML is in preparation and will be shared with the EB.

## IFCC Practice Guidelines in Laboratory Medicine

There will be a meeting in February, 2023, to discuss the IFCC practice guidelines project. KA will send draft ToR and a template for the new project prior to meeting with Chairs and Committees.

#### WASPaLM collaboration

No update at this time. Will follow up in the New Year.
